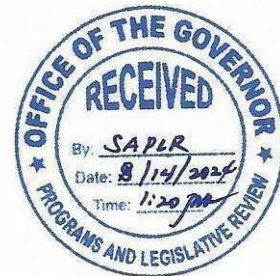
Dear Governor Palacios:

**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate the \$72,200 of the Rota Poker License Fees account (specifically under BU 3302).

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO
CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1 **SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.**

2 The Rota Legislative Delegation (Delegation) acknowledges the various needs the Rota
3 community has, of which services are provided to by different entities, bodies, and benefits such
4 as the Delegation, the 19th Rota Municipal Council, the Rota Municipal Scholarship, and the Rota
5 Medical Subsistence Allowance. The Delegation finds that providing the aforementioned entities
6 with adequate funding from the Rota Poker License Fees to aid in operations is necessary and in
7 the best interest of the Rota Community.

8 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate the \$72,200 under Business Unit 3302.

9 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.**

10 Notwithstanding 10 CMC § 1901, \$72,200 of the Rota Poker Licensing Fee Account,

1 Business Unit 3302, is appropriated as follows:

- 2 (a) \$21,000 for the Office of the Mayor of Rota. The expenditure authority of the funds under this
3 subsection is the Mayor of the Rota.
- 4 (b) \$20,900 for the Rota Medical Subsistence Allowance. The expenditure authority of the funds
5 under this subsection is the Secretary of the Department of Finance.
- 6 (c) \$29,000 for the Rota Legislative Delegation. The expenditure authority of the funds under this
7 subsection is the Chairman of the Rota Legislative Delegation.
- 8 (d) \$1,300 for the 19th Rota Municipal Council for fuel and lubricants. The expenditure authority
9 of the funds under this subsection is the Chairman of the Rota Municipal Council.

10 **SECTION 3. REPROGRAMMING.**

11 The funds under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for other purposes and the funds shall
12 not be subject to fiscal year limitation.

13 **SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.**

14 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or
15 circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act
16 or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held
17 invalid shall not be affected thereby.

18 **SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**


19 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing
20 right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or
21 order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding
22 instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of

1 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in
2 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.


3 **SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

4 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming law without
5 such approval.

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


